## **Add ERS to your Endorsement**

Endorsed Reflective Supervisor

Provide qualifying hours to other professionals. Receive RSC from another Endorsed Reflective Supervisor (ERS) or I/ECMHM-C endorsee to maintain your Endorsement.

Use Endorsed Reflective Supervisor to be listed on your association's RSC registry.

# Are you already endorsed at a category that qualifies you to provide RSC?

If you are endorsed as Family Reflective Supervisor (I/ECFRS), you already meet the requirements for ERS! Your I/ECFRS application will automatically be adjusted in the EASy system to reflect this, and you can start using ERS now!

Mental Health Mentor- Clinical endorsees are still qualified to provide to all professionals,

including other MHM-C endorsees and applicants.
